- ✚ As per Notification by Higher Education department, Govt of West Bengal (434-Edn(CS)/10M-95/14 dated 16/07/2020) Admission Process will be through **ONLINE**.
- ✚ Candidates qualified in H.S. or equivalent (10+2 Std) examination in **2020/2019/2018/2017** will be able to participate in the admission process.
- ✚ A Candidate may be **admitted into the same college not more than twice**. In that case previous registration of the Burdwan University will be applicable.

- ✚ **Before entering the admission portal candidates are advised to keep the following things ready:**
 1. Scanned passport size photo and signature in PNG/JPG format

2. Scanned copy of admit and marksheet of Madhyamik or equivalent (10 std) examination in PDF/PNG/JPG format
3. Scanned copy of marksheet of H.S. or equivalent (10 +2 std) examination in PDF/PNG/JPG format
4. Scanned copy of S.C./S.T./OBC-A/OBC-B /PwD certificate approved by West Bengal Govt. in PDF/PNG/JPG format (If applicable)
5. Size of each file must be less than 1 MB
6. Candidate's Mobile number for sending OTP, Password and other information
7. Fees to be paid through online via CREDIT CARD/DEBIT CARD/NET BANKING etc.
8. Email address and Aadhar number of candidate
9. Bank a/c number, a/c holder name and IFSC code of the bank of the candidate/guardian.

BRIEF OF THE PROCESS FOR ONLINE FORM FILL UP

It has three steps: (1) Registration (2) Selection of General Course; (3) Selection of honours courses.

Step 1: For Registration

(From college website) ONLINE ADMISSION 2020 **OR**
<http://ssc.admissions.net.in> → LOGIN/REGISTER → New User? Create Account → Fill up the fields of personal details → Type the Captcha code → Continue to Step II → Fill up the fields (Parental details) → Continue to Step III → Fill up the fields (Marks details) from drop/down panels (write full name of subjects e.g. Bengali, Chemistry etc, full marks 100, theory & practical/project marks separately) → Continue to Step IV → Upload the documents → Continue to Step V → Enter verification code (4 digit number will be come to your mobile after completion step I) → Verify & Proceed to Registration Fee Payment → Choose payment mode →

Select Bank → (Pay Rs 230+bank charge) → You will get SMS with login Id and Password. Registration is completed.

Step 2: Selection of General course

Go To Dashboard → Select Course → Choose General course → Apply Now → Fill up the fields → Review & Confirm → Confirm & Proceed to Payment (no payment is required) → Captcha Code → Validate Application

Step 3: Selection of Honours course (If candidate is interested to apply for Honours course)

Go To Dashboard → Select Course → Choose Honours Subject → Apply Now → Fill up the fields (field 1 for Hons subject , field 2 and 3 for generic subjects) → Review & Confirm → Confirm & Proceed to Payment → Pay online & pay now → Choose payment mode (Rs.35+bank charge)

GENERAL INSTRUCTION

1. The admission criteria of “The University of Burdwan” & Higher Education department, W.B. will be strictly followed for admission in Honours and General course.
2. For admission please visit www.syamsundarcollege.ac.in and follow the link **ONLINE ADMISSION 2020** at right corner **OR** go to <http://ssc.admissions.net.in>.
3. Please enter all data (in personal details, parental details, marks details) in the respective fields very carefully and correctly. In marks details **include all subjects of HS markshit, write full form of the subject (e.g. Bengali, English, Mathematics, Biology etc), full marks is 100**. Write theory marks and practical/project marks separately. Then fill up the mark details for Madhyamik (10 std) Examination. Write marks obtained in each subject in the column of “Theory Marks” .

The **mobile number must be yours. Fields with * mark must be filled up. Otherwise, you cannot move to next step.** Any incorrect or false entry will lead to cancellation of admission at any point of detection. Candidate will be registered for admission only after online payment of registration fee of Rs. 230.00 + bank charge (bank charge is subsidized by reducing the registration fee).

4. After completion of registration **“LOGIN ID” and “PASSWORD”** will be sent to your registered mobile number. Keep your mobile no., login Id and password carefully for future.
5. Candidates must have to **apply first for Arts/Commerce/Science “General” course and then only will be provided to select desired Honours** subjects according to his/her eligibility. With the Honours subject two other subjects have to be chosen as combination (Generic subject).
6. **Rs. 35.00 + bank charge will be paid for applying each Honours course** (bank charge is subsidized by reducing the application fee). No payment is required for applying General course.
7. Candidates will be able to **APPLY/VIEW** different subjects after successfully registering themselves through **“LOGIN/REGISTER”** button.
8. All candidates are requested to **regularly visit admission portal of the college** for all updates and information. College will not be responsible for any kind of network related issues.
9. Reservation of seats in different courses will be followed by West Bengal Govt. rules and regulations.
10. Complete provisional merit list for each course will be published in stipulated time. After corrections (if any mistake occurs in filling up the form by candidate) **complete final merit list for each course will be displayed.**
11. For **corrections** (after publication of provisional merit list) candidates are requested to contact with College authority through **EMAIL only (syamsundaradm@gmail.com).**
12. **Merit list for admission in different courses will be published in different phases** (i.e. 1st merit list, 2nd merit list etc) if vacancy exists. **Successful candidates** have to **LOGIN** and then click on **“My Applications”**. Click on the honours

subject at which “Offered Admission” is mentioned. From drop/down panel choose “Pay Admission Fees” and “Go”. Then make PAYMENT for the admission in the course. **Failing to pay the required amount within due date will automatically cancel the chance of admission.**

13. If a candidate first gets a chance for any of the “General Course” and make payment for admission but latter, gets a chance in any “Honours Course” the **amount previously paid may be adjusted** according to system configuration. The same rule will be applicable during change from one “Honours” subject to another of choice but in no case any balance excess amount will be refundable.
14. The admitted candidates will be required to **verify their all original testimonials** (admit card, marksheet, payment receipt, cast certificate if applicable etc.) only after the normalization of the current situation. If any **false entry is observed in the application admission of the candidate will be cancelled and no refund will be paid.**
15. **The decision of college authority will be final in any matter related to the admission.**

Bengali, Defense Studies, History, Philosophy, Physical Education, Political Science, Sanskrit.

✚ MERIT POINT CALCULATIONS (Percentage of marks for each paper will be considered):

(a) For Honours Course:

➤ For five or more subjects in H.S. or equivalent :

Merit point = Marks of Best of 5 subjects (excluding ENVS) + Marks of Subject for which Honours is chosen

➤ For one language and three subjects in H.S. or equivalent :

Merit point = 2 x Marks of Language + Marks of 3 subjects (excluding ENVS) + Marks of Subject for which Honours is chosen.

➤ For Botany/Zoology/Environmental Science Honours: Marks of Biology should be considered as marks of subject.

➤ If the concerned Honours subject is not available in H.S.: Consider the marks of language (Highest amongst all languages) as marks of subject.

➤ If Environmental Science is a Compulsory/Optional Elective subject it may be considered within 5 concerned subjects

➤ For same merit points:

- (i)** Subject for Honours marks shall be considered
- (ii)** Highest marks in language shall be considered
- (iii)** Marks in M.P. (10 std) examination will be considered

(b) For General Course :

➤ For five or more subjects H.S. or equivalent:

Merit point = Marks of Best of 5 subjects (excluding ENVS)

➤ For one language and three subjects in H.S. or equivalent :

Merit point = 2 x Marks of Language + Marks of 3 subjects (excluding ENVS)

- If Environmental Science is a Compulsory/Optional Elective subject it may be considered within 5 concerned subjects
- **For same merit points:**
 - (i) Highest marks in language (Highest among all languages) shall be considered
 - (ii) Marks in M.P. (10 std) examination will be considered
